

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HANOVER

BY-LAW NO. 1606 -04-21-87

A BY-LAW to prohibit or regulate noise in the Town of Hanover, likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Town of Hanover.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, Chapter 302, R.S.O. 1980, Section 210, Subsection 132 enables Councils to pass By-Laws for prohibiting or regulating noise likely to disturb the Inhabitants.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hanover deems it advisable and expedient to pass such a by-law.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hanover enacts as follows:


1. No person shall, within the Corporate limits of the Town of Hanover ring any bell, blow or sound any horn, shout or make any unusual noise likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Town of Hanover or cause or permit the same to be made.
2. No person shall cause or permit persistent noise by a pet likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Town of Hanover.
3. Persons contravening this By-Law shall upon conviction thereof forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars for each such offence and every such penalty shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 400, as amended.
4. This By-Law shall come into force and effect on the final reading thereof, and here by repeals by-law 1452-04-16-84.


Read a first time this 21st day of April, 1987
