PROGRAMS/SERVICES WHICH MAY BE COVERED BY FEE AS- SISTANCE

Any programs or services directly offered by the Town of Hanover may be considered for fee assistance.

The following do not qualify: course materials, (i.e. manuals, exam fees, supplies), programs that are contracted to private instructors (trips, specialty camps, advanced courses), and swim passes.

We believe that all residents should have equal access to our services through:

- affordable fees
- financial help with fees for residents when needed
- payment plans for registration or membership fees if approved (up to a maximum 60% subsidy per registration fee or membership)

IT'S EASY TO APPLY

Application Forms

- Available at Parks, Recreation & Culture Office and online at hanover.ca/prc.
- Attach the required documents

Required Documents:

1. identification for applicant (health card, birth certificate or passport)
2. proof of Hanover residency
3. proof of income (current income tax return, gst/hst credit statement, Canada Child Tax Benefit Statement, Universal Child Care Benefit Statement)
4. fee assistance application form

Bring your completed application form and required documents to the P & H Centre's Customer Service Desk.

Applications will be reviewed by Manager of Aquatics & Programs. Upon approval, applicants must pay applicable fees prior to program start date.

Fee assistance will be determined by proof of total household gross income and based on the current Statistics Canada Low Income Cut-Off (LICO) before tax information.
