She provides overall guidance and direction for sales and marketing initiatives.

Sandy and her husband Jamie are joint owners of the Ice River Springs Group and have a passion for healthy products that are good for people and good for the earth. They have owned several successful businesses in the area over the past 30 years.

Ice River Springs is an amazing success story of a family-owned, family-run business growing from small to large. Ice River Springs was created in May 1995 by Jamie and Sandy Gott on their family farm located just outside the small town of Feversham, Ontario, Canada.

In 2010 Ice River Springs created a state of the art recycling facility in Shelburne, Ontario called "Blue Mountain Plastics" that utilizes leading edge technologies and processes to produce food grade recycled plastic that is made into 100% recycled water bottles. This highly innovative project allows Ice River Springs to be the first manufacturer of food grade recycled plastic in North America in a closed loop system. All bottled water produced by Ice River Springs in Canada is manufactured from 100% recycled plastic. Other materials sorted at Blue Mountain Plastics are used for recycled outdoor furniture through a related company, CR Plastics in Stratford, Ontario.

Currently Ice River Springs has 13 plants across North America and approximately 600 team members.
