The application was reviewed by the Planning Advisory Committee on July 6, 2021 and August 3, 2021 for zoning by-law compliance. Scott Taylor, Senior Planner, County of Grey reviewed the application on behalf of the Town. Comments were received from Grey County Planning, Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority, Amanda Courtney, Gordon Francis, Brittanny Lelieveld, Matt Schierz, Lauralea & Dan Bruton and Jordan Whitmore. Comments were also received from Loukia Georgiou today.
